<u>Pool</u>

Two new sets of tables and chairs have finally arrived and been installed at the pool. These replaced the old ones that had been removed due to deterioration and rust. The chaise lounges that were restrung in 2019 have held up well and remain at the poolside. Residents sunbathing at the pool are requested to use a towel on the lounge chairs to help prevent damage to the chairs that may be caused by chemicals contained in certain sunscreens. Please be sure to shower and allow sunscreen to dry prior to entering the pool. Doing so is important to help maintain the cleanliness of the pool. Showers are located in the restrooms near the pool.

Water Conservation

The Honolulu Board of Water Supply (BWS) continues to request that Oahu residents use less water, especially during the dry summer months. This is due to fuel leaking into the aquifer from the Navy's Red Hill complex which sits 100 feet above the main water source for much of Oahu. Resident Manager Mike Bravo has made several changes to reduce PHK's water usage. Residents are encouraged to conserve water too, for example: washing clothes and dishes only in full loads; taking shorter showers; and not running the water while brushing your teeth.
