# Being Good Neighbors Animal Feeding

Residents are reminded to not put out food for birds or other animals. Birds have been increasingly roosting and nesting on PHK balconies. Feeding animals on the property is prohibited under the House Rules. (House Rules pages 8, and 14)

### **Birds and bird netting**

Residents may install bird netting on their lanais to keep birds from landing. Bird netting must be installed without damaging the building. Please contact Mike Bravo, Resident Manager, for authorized materials to use and the specifications for correctly installing bird netting.

### **Parking Stalls**

Due to the ongoing concern with inappropriate items stored in parking stalls, the Board has asked our RM to follow-up with Residents to have these items removed. Specifics of items that are allowed, and those that are prohibited, are listed in the House Rules. Citations may be issued if items are not removed. (House Rules page 17)

#### **Noise**

Please remember, sound travels widely in a condominium community. Be considerate of your

neighbors and keep the volume of your activities (e.g. music, television, movies, parties) at a reasonable level. This includes activities at the pool.

### **PHK Staff and contractors**

Residents are reminded that Association personnel are not permitted to perform work within any apartment for any Resident, unless authorized and instructed to do so by the Board of Directors. This applies during regular work hours and/or after work hours and on weekends. This prohibition also applies to our contracted housekeeping, maintenance, and groundskeeping staff.
