#### **Smoke Alarms**

Owners and Residents are reminded that, by law, working smoke detectors must be installed in all apartments. The Honolulu Fire Department recommends that smoke detectors be placed in all sleeping areas, outside of each separate sleeping area (e.g. hallway, but not the bathroom), and on each level of the apartment. For specific guidance on proper placement, go to fire.honolulu.gov/fire-and-lifesafety/homeowners/smokealarms. Smoke detectors should be tested monthly to ensure they are working and to familiarize

residents with the sound. The batteries should be replaced at least every year and the smoke alarm should be replaced at least every 10 years.

# House Rules & Good Neighbor Reminders

All residents are expected to follow the House Rules. Copies of the House Rules are available in the PHK office.

All trash should be securely enclosed in a tied trash bag prior to disposal down the trash chute. If necessary, double bag trash to ensure the bag does not leak in the trash chute. Cat litter, diapers, and other similar rubbish should be placed in double bags. Failure to follow this process causes odors, roaches, and other pests.

Residents are reminded that advance notice must be given to Craig for all move-ins/move-outs, and deliveries of furniture, applicants, and bulky items that require the use of the elevator. Padding must be installed to protect the elevator interior.
