What Goes In Your Commingle Bin

<u>Cardboard:</u> Clean corrugated cardboard, white cardboard <u>NO</u> : Wax cardboard, wet cardboard, oil boxes, oily pizza boxes
Aluminum and Bi-Metal Aluminum Cans, Tin cans = Drinking, Food cans (labels OK must be rinsed out)
Newspaper Deposit loose in bin NO Phone books, Magazines, Books
Plastic All Plastics #'s 1-5 Drink bottles, Milk jugs, and Detergent containers. Remove caps and tops and rinse clean
NO Liquids, Plastic grocery bags

^{*}Unauthorized items may be subject to additional contamination charges.

^{**}If your account is allowed to throw away bagged office paper, only clear bags should be used so the internal contents are visible.

^{***}If you throw away bagged recycle items, only clear bags should be used so the internal contents are visible.
