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DECLARATION OF COVENANTS IN FAVOR OF WAILUPE PENINSULA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

THIS DECLARATION OF COVENANTS IN FAVOR OF WAILUPE PENINSULA COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION (this "**Declaration**") is dated _______, and is executed by _______, whose address is _______ (the "**Owner**"). This Declaration, when fully executed, shall be effective on the date that this Declaration is filed in the Office of the Assistant Registrar of the Land Court of the State of Hawaii (the "**Effective Date**").

RECITALS:

A. The Owner is the owner of certain real property located in the City and County of Honolulu, State of Hawaii, which real property is more particularly described in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the real property and the improvements thereon being referred to herein as the "**Property**").

B. Under the terms of this Declaration, the Owner intends to impose certain covenants on the Property pertaining to Wailupe Peninsula Community Association, a Hawaii nonprofit corporation (the "Association"), on the terms and provisions set forth below, which covenants would (i) burden the Property and be binding upon any owner of the Property and its successors, successors in title and assigns, and (ii) be covenants running with the land described in Exhibit A attached hereto.

C. The Owner is entering into and recording this Declaration on the terms and provisions set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Owner hereby declares and covenants as follows:

ARTICLE I Declaration and Covenants

The Owner hereby declares and covenants that, from and after the Effective Date, the Property, including all improvements constructed or to be constructed thereon, shall be held, sold conveyed, encumbered, occupied, used and improved subject to the terms and provisions of this Declaration, which terms and provisions (i) encumber and burden the Property, and (ii) are for the benefit of the Association. The Owner further declares and covenants that the terms and provisions of this Declaration (i) shall run with the land described in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and shall be binding upon the Owner, as the current owner of the Property, its successors, successors in title and assigns and any person or entity having any right, title or interest in the Property or any part thereof or interest therein, and (ii) shall inure to the benefit of and be enforceable by the Association, and its successors and assigns.

The Owner further declares and covenants that, from and after the Effective Date, the Owner shall be a voting member of the Association and shall be bound by all of the covenants and obligations that such membership entails, including the payment of maintenance fees in such amounts as are determined by the Board of Directors of the Association (the "**Board**"), and the observance of all rules and regulations promulgated by the Board.

The Owner further declares and covenants that this covenant regarding membership in the Association shall bind the Property and be automatically incorporated in all subsequent deeds conveying any portion of the Property.

ARTICLE II Duration and Enforcement

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Duration</u>. The terms and provisions of this Declaration shall continue and remain in full force and effect for such period of time that the Association or any successor or replacement entity remains in effect.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Enforcement</u>. The Association shall have the right, but shall not be obligated, to enforce the terms this Declaration by any proceeding at law or in equity, against any person or entity violating or attempting to violate the terms of this Declaration.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>No Waiver</u>. No failure by the Association to enforce the terms of this Declaration shall constitute a waiver by the Association of such enforcement right in another case or circumstance.

ARTICLE III Acknowledgment by the Association

By signing below, the Association hereby acknowledges the terms and conditions of this Declaration.

ARTICLE IV Miscellaneous

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Binding Effect</u>. This Declaration shall be binding upon and enforceable against the Owner and its successors, successors in title and assigns, and shall inure to the benefit of the Association and its successors and assigns. The terms and provisions of this Declaration shall run with the land described in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto.

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Governing Law</u>. This Declaration shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Hawaii. Any dispute or enforcement proceeding concerning this Declaration shall be resolved in the federal and state courts of Hawaii.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Amendment</u>. This Declaration may be amended by a written instrument signed by the Owner and the Association, which written instrument shall be filed in the Office of the Assistant Registrar of the Land Court of the State of Hawaii.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Counterparts</u>. This Declaration may be executed in counterparts, each of which so executed shall, irrespective of the date of its execution and delivery, be deemed, an original, and said counterparts together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
